Official Rules & Guidelines

These rules apply to all Artist Alley participants, Commercial Vendors, Guests, and any exhibitors utilizing space within the Exhibit Hall.

1. Space & Booth Allocation Information

Standard Spaces: (All available booths will be posted in the application)

- **Artist Table:** Includes one (1) 6-foot table, two (2) chairs, and two (2) badges.
- **Vendor Booth:** Includes one (1) 10' x 10' space, one (1) 8-foot table, two (2) chairs, and two (2) badges **-or-** one (1) 10' x 20' space, two (2) 8-foot tables, four (4) chairs, and four (4) badges.

Sharing Policy:

A table or booth is not to be shared by two separate businesses. One location per registered business, with no exceptions.

Utilities:

- **Electricity:** Electricity is not included with your space. It must be ordered separately prior to the show or directly from our on-site decorator during setup. (subject to change)
- **Wi-Fi:** Wi-Fi is not guaranteed by Arise Con. We highly encourage all vendors to bring their own cellular hot-spots or data plans to process payments.

2. Check-In, Set Up, and Break Down

- **Check-In:** All vendors must check-in at the designated Vendor Registration Desk (located on the 2nd Floor, West Side of the Convention Center) to receive their vendor badges prior to setting up their space. Complete arrival logistics including designated loading dock locations, maps, and parking instructions will be sent directly to your registered email address once your application is approved and registration is fully completed.
- **Loading and Equipment:** Vendors are entirely responsible for loading their own merchandise, supplies, and displays into and out of the venue. Please bring your own carts, hand trucks, or dollies, as the convention facility does not provide this equipment.
- **Space Boundaries:** You must load in and set up within your designated, taped boundaries on the floor. All tables, racks, displays, and merchandise must remain completely within your assigned space.
- **Display Restrictions:** Absolutely nothing may be attached, taped, or hung on the venue walls. Display stands, backdrops, and banners are permitted as long as they are free-standing and do not damage facility property.
- **Table Covers:** Standard tables do not include table cloths. Vendors should bring their own professional table coverings that drape to the floor.

3. General Conduct & Safety Rules

- **Cleanliness:** Each vendor is responsible for keeping their assigned area clean and free of trash throughout the weekend.
- **No Smoking or Vaping:** Smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited inside the facility per Nevada state law and city ordinances. If caught smoking or vaping inside, you will be removed from the premises without a refund.
- **Security & Stolen Property:** Arise Con is not responsible for any merchandise sold by vendors, nor are we liable for stolen property. Please secure your cash drawers, devices, and high-value items at all times, especially overnight.

- **Adult Material (18+):** Vendors agree not to publicly display sexually explicit or adult material. Any 18+ items must be discreetly censored and kept behind counters. ID checks are strictly required before showing or selling adult material to any attendee.
 - *Penalties:* 1st Offense: Warning and mandatory correction; 2nd Offense: Removal of the product from the floor; 3rd Offense: Immediate expulsion from the event and future blacklisting.
- **Gambling:** Gambling of any form is prohibited in the Exhibit floor.
- **Photography Consent:** While photography is encouraged, you must respect the rights of artists and other vendors who request that their work not be photographed.
- **Aisle Obstruction:** Do not run promotional activities, lines, or displays in front of your booth that block the flow of traffic in the aisles.
- **Local Taxes & Fire Regulations:** Vendors must comply with all Nevada state, Clark County, and federal sales tax requirements. You must also adhere to all local Fire Marshal guidelines, including keeping electrical access points clear and avoiding flammable display materials.

4. Merchandise Policies (Bootlegs, Fanart, AI)

- **Fanart Policy:** Original fanart created by the artist in their own unique style is permitted.
- **AI Artwork Ban:** Artwork generated by Artificial Intelligence (AI) is **strictly prohibited** from being sold in any format at Arise Con. Selling AI-generated items will result in an immediate ban from future events and you will be removed from the venue without a refund.
- **Bootleg/Pirated Goods:** Selling counterfeit, bootleg, or unlicensed merchandise (physical or digital) is strictly prohibited. If you are found selling pirated items, you will be removed from the venue without a refund.
- **Drug Paraphernalia:** Products derived from controlled substances or drug paraphernalia are not permitted. Offering these items for sale will result in immediate, permanent removal and a lifetime ban.

5. Weapons & Dangerous Goods Policies

- **Prop Weapons:** No functional projectile weapons, firearms, or sharp metal blades are allowed. Replica guns must have a highly visible orange safety tip on the barrel. All questionable props must be checked and tagged by our Weapons Security team at the entrance of the Exhibit Hall.
- **Gases & Chemicals:** Helium tanks, propane, or other flammable gases are prohibited. The sale of chemical self-defense items (such as pepper spray, mace, or tear gas) is strictly prohibited inside the Exhibit Hall to ensure a safe, family-friendly environment for all attendees.

6. Refund & Cancellation Policy

Our refund tiered system is as follows for **Arise Con 2026**:

- **100% Refund:** If canceled on or before **May 31, 2026**.
- **50% Refund:** If canceled on or before **June 15, 2026**.
- **25% Refund:** If canceled on or before **July 15, 2026**.
- **No Refunds:** After **July 15, 2026**, except in the extreme event of a complete convention cancellation without a rescheduled date.

To ensure a seamless experience for all attendees and Exhibit Hall patrons, we require immediate notification if you are unable to attend.

Because empty tables or booths negatively affect the energy of the show floor, unreported no-shows will lose their "Preferred Vendor Status" during future registrations, be placed on a Secondary Review pool for future applications (which impacts general eligibility and early-bird selection), and receive a lower placement priority for future events.

All cancellations are final. Please consider your space booking carefully.

7. Harassment Policy

Harassment, bullying, profanity, or aggressive behavior of any kind toward staff, volunteers, fellow vendors, or attendees will not be tolerated and will lead to disciplinary action, up to and including immediate expulsion from the event without a refund.

In the event of an incident, we ask that vendors do not take matters into their own hands. Please contact Arise Con staff or security immediately. Our dedicated security team will be stationed by the Security station across from the Exhibit Hall entrance and patrolling the floor to assist you in real time.

Please respect everyone's right to personal consent, comfort boundaries, and choice. Be smart, stay safe, and be kind.

8. Acknowledgment & Changes

Failure to follow, uphold, or respect these guidelines in good faith will result in disciplinary measures at the sole discretion of Arise Con and venue operations.

- **Rule Changes:** Rules are subject to being added, changed, and/or revised at any time to ensure the safety of the venue. Vendors are expected to adhere to all official updates and will be notified of any major changes.
- **Master Rules:** Everyone present at the event is required to adhere to the Convention Rules posted on our official website.
